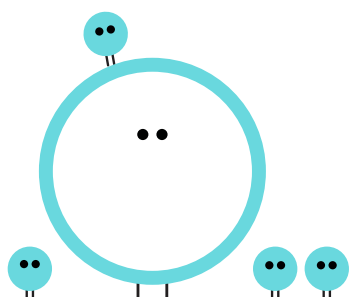

Music and Materials
